Earth Week Tips and Information

1. Turn off the lights when you leave a room

5. Use reusable water bottles and cups instead of plastic disposable ones
6. Plant something!
7. Unplug cords that are not in use
8. Bike, walk, or scooter instead of getting a ride to school, sports, or friends house!
9. Bring reusable forks, spoons, and containers in your lunch
10. Ask your grown up to bring reusable bags when shopping
11. No idling. Did you know it is illegal to sit with car on in a school zone?
Idling is considered when more than 3 minutes sitting with car on.
