### Principal Update – Dr. Wagner

1. School Safety
  - a. Want to focus on being transparent about safety. Presentation during the November General PTA meeting - **School Year Safety Update Presentation.**
  - b. Dr Wagner presented it to the board and the board suggested that this be done in the evening to assure more attendance as this is an important topic. Dr Wagner said there would be a recording but maybe it becomes a stand alone meeting instead of linking it with the PTA meeting.
2. The Parent Teacher Conferences went well and looking forward to to having them again next week.

### Treasurers – Erika Nelander and Mackenzie Gapastione

1. September Balance - \$78,754
  - a. \$10K of that is outstanding checks
  - b. Golf made \$21K and had \$6k in expenses
2. PE Budget allocation
  - a. Playground equipment purchased. Used \$150 from PE allowance, \$150 from Mr Filus staff allowance and \$617 from teacher experience (school beautification line item)
3. One Book One School and Subscriptions budget allocations
  - a. Need to purchase more books - \$750. Unanimously voted on using money from the cash reserve fund. Also need an additional \$225 for subscriptions and will also use money from cash reserve budget line
4. PTA Membership Update
  - a. Jen and Liz entering PTA memberships and Veronica will enter teacher memberships

1. Approve Minutes from 9/20/23 General meeting and 9/15/23 board meeting
  - a. Minutes were unanimously approved
2. Teacher Grants- Applications distributed next week, entries between Nov. 1st- Nov. 15th
  - a. There is \$2K available for teacher grants
3. Teacher Allowances - Communicated to staff
  - a. Heather O'Donnell has communicated to staff their budgeted staff allowance
4. DG58 School Board Monthly Meetings – Board to sign-up on google drive
  - a. PD will present at the December meeting so Jen Klemz will switch with Mackenzie
5. PTA Facebook page
  - a. The FB page went private. Keeping the public one with a post stating that there is a new page.
  - b. 71 people have joined the group
6. Storage at school: homecoming flag, pawsome signs, welcome to PD, a few bins
  - a. PTA needs one place for storage. Dr. Wagner approved for the homecoming flag and other items to be stored in the storage where the lawn mower/snow blade is stored
